Would you like to become a SuperSaver? Here's how it works...

SuperSaver start date will be **September 21, 2017**.

You may bank each week with as little as 25 cents or as much as you would like to deposit. Make a deposit to your account on at least 90% and above of the Bank Days throughout the school year, and you will be eligible for your Grades' Super Saver Award. A \$10.00 deposit to your account for the most consistent saver (all ties will be awarded). Each Grade's award winning Super Saver automatically qualifies for the **GRAND PRIZE DRAWING**. Steady Savers earn a \$5.00 deposit to their account for banking at least 90% of available Bank Days.

School Trips - Fundraising and Banking

Your child will have the opportunity to go on four big trips during their time at the Edgartown School (and all the island elementary schools). It is expected that all students will go on these trips with the exception of the Shenandoah which is not school sponsored.

The first is the Shenandoah. This 5 night 6 day trip happens during the summer between 5th and 6th grade. This trip is parent run and not required or sponsored by the school. However, there is fundraising through chocolate making at the school with parent volunteers for this \$550 trip.

The second is a Sixth grade trip to Camp Alton Jones. This trip is three nights and four days. It takes place in September of 6th grade year. The 2017 cost of this trip is \$295. There is no fundraising for this trip.

The third trip is the 7th grade Ski Trip to Gunstock Mountain in New Hampshire. It takes place in February of 7th grade. It is a two night three day stay with 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ days of skiing (including lessons) and one night of tubing. The 2017 cost of this trip is \$350. There is some fundraising for this trip.

The fourth trip is the 8th grade trip to Washington DC. It takes place in May/June of 8th grade and is a four night five day trip to our nations capital. The 2017 cost of this trip is \$1400. There are multiple opportunities for fundraising for this trip. If you participate fully in all of them, you can cover the cost of your trip. Most people are able to raise at least half the amount needed.

8th graders will need specific clothing for the DC trip as well as fancy clothes for graduation. These are other expenses to consider.

If you haven't started the banking program already, now is a good time. The Martha's Vineyard Savings Bank school banking program offers a real interest earnings savings account to students that can be kept beyond a student's time at the Edgartown School. It is a financially responsible way to ensure participation in these trips without stress.

Below is a chart to help budget for these trips and reduce financial stress. Banking money is yours and will travel with you to whatever school you attend.

Viagens Escolares - Fundraising and Banking

Sua criança terá a oportunidade de ir em quatro viagens grandes durante seu tempo na escola de Edgartown (e em todas as escolas elementares da ilha). Espera-se que todos os alunos irão nestas viagens com exceção do Shenandoah que não é patrocinado pela escola.

O primeiro é o Shenandoah. Esta 5 noite 6 viagem de um dia acontece durante o verão entre 5^a e 6^a série. Esta viagem é dirigida pelos pais e não exigida ou patrocinada pela escola. No entanto, há fundraising através de chocolate fazendo na escola com os pais voluntários para esta viagem \$ 550.

O segundo é uma viagem de sexto grau ao acampamento Alton Jones. Esta viagem é de três noites e quatro dias. Ocorre em setembro do ano da 6^a série. O custo de 2017 desta viagem é de US \$ 295. Não há fundraising para esta viagem.

A terceira viagem é a 7^a série Ski viagem para Gunstock Mountain em New Hampshire. Realiza-se em fevereiro da 7^a série. É uma estadia de três dias de três noites com 1 ½ dias de esqui (incluindo aulas) e uma noite de tubulação. O custo de 2017 desta viagem é de R \$ 350. Há algum fundraising para esta viagem.

A quarta viagem é a 8^a série de viagem para Washington DC. Tem lugar em maio / junho de 8^o ano e é uma viagem de quatro dias cinco dias para a nossa capital das nações. O custo de 2017 desta viagem é de US \$ 1400. Existem várias oportunidades para angariação de fundos para esta viagem. Se você participar plenamente de todos eles, você pode cobrir o custo de sua viagem. A maioria das

pessoas é capaz de aumentar pelo menos metade da quantidade necessária.

Alunos de 8º vai precisar de roupas específicas para a viagem DC, bem como roupas de fantasia para a graduação. Estas são outras despesas a considerar.

Se você ainda não começou o programa bancário já, agora é um bom momento. O Martha's Vineyard Savings Bank programa bancário escolar oferece uma conta de poupança real interesse ganhos para os alunos que podem ser mantidos para além do tempo de um aluno na Escola Edgartown. É uma forma financeiramente responsável de garantir a participação nessas viagens sem estresse.
