### THE RULES OF THE HOMEWORK CLUB

**Homework Club is a time for students to work on homework and receive assistance if needed. Students make a commitment to stay after school for an hour to work on their homework; therefore, it is very important that all students are respectful of each other's time and homework environment.**

1. The Homework Club needs to be a quiet space where students can concentrate and get school work done. You can certainly ask for and receive help but be thoughtful of others. All students may not be working on the same question or subject, so please keep your voices low.
2. You are expected to be working diligently on homework while you are at the Homework Club.
3. You must check in with your Homework Club teacher by 2:45 PM so that she knows who is attending. If you need to see another teacher before coming to the Homework Club, FIRST check in with the Homework Club teacher and let her know where you are going. After 2:45, no one will be admitted into the Homework Club without a note from a teacher.
4. You may not leave the building before Homework Club. A snack will be provided.
5. Once you sign in for Homework Club, you are making the commitment to stay until 3:45 PM. If you need to leave earlier than 3:45 PM, you will need to get a note from your parents stating the time that you need to leave. Homework Club is officially over at 3:45 PM.
6. Chairs must be placed on the tables before leaving the room.
7. We hope that your time at the Homework Club is beneficial to you. Study hard, get all your work completed, and watch your grades improve!!
8. Please always bring a book to read when you have finished your other homework.
9. All school rules outlined in the Student Handbook apply. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated in Homework Club. Any student whose behavior continues to be disruptive will be sent to the office, a phone call home will be made, and the student may return to Homework Club after one week.
