

Sixth Grade Parents,

June is creeping up on us!! All of us here in the 6th grade are gearing up for our Heifer International adventure. We are all paid-up and ready for the experience! Together, we are headed out to Rutland, Mass. on **June 17th** to take part in Heifer International's Global Village Tour. Students will learn about cultures from around the world by first taking part in a guided tour of the eight world villages and their corresponding cultural gardens. By lunch, we will all be hungry and so will split into small groups and each head off to one of eight cultural villages. Once situated in the "village", the group will communally create their very own lunch. Group members will be busy as grain will need to be crushed, fires made, dough kneaded, vegetables cut, pans prepared for the fire, and ingredients mixed together with precious little water. Each group will enjoy a lunch indicative of his/her cultural village. I ate in the Peruvian village last year and enjoyed hot tamales, beans and hot, sugary coffee - all cooked over an open fire that was built by students. Building our fire was interesting!

We are headed out on the **7:00a.m. boat from Vineyard Haven**. Students **should arrive no later than 6:30a.m.** Your child should enjoy a satisfying **breakfast at home** or bring breakfast to the boat. Students will not have access to the food court on the ferry. As always, **soda, candy, chips, and gum are not allowed** on this trip. Please no packed milk. You may wish to **pack a snack** and a **water bottle** as we have an hour and a half ride to Rutland - please, no canned or bottled drinks. We should arrive at Overlook Farm by 10:00 for the start of our day. Our program finishes at 2:30p.m, at which time we will start **back for the 6:15 p.m.** ferry. Your child may be hungry by the time we hit the Cape and so we will stop for pizza and water in Falmouth. The cost of pizza and water has been figured into the cost of the trip.
