- Promised funds to Melinda for Green House electrical project (\$7,500) and approved 3 hydration stations for School (approx. \$1,000 each) from Grace Manson/Robert Day Grant money

- Upcoming Evening of Entertainment with Silent Auction, dine to donate, and music by Joanne Cassidy to be held Saturday Nov. 23 at The Wharf Restaurant (also Gina's Birthday)
  - o Cost of Band is \$2,500
  - Need to presale tickets and form an Auction committee (Deanna, Brooke, Jen O'Hanon, Joanne Chivinski, Claire Crowell)
  - All members asked to look for donations for auction
    - Emily Reddington offered a week of STEM camp (Brooke follow up)
- Halloween Party (Corey Marolf)
  - Party set for October 25, still looking for volunteers, offer community service hours to 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders who help with set up and game management
    - Anne Fligor to take proposal to Student Council
  - Approved purchase of trophy pendants, 1 new decoration, plastic plates and plastic wall murals
  - Approved purchase of pizza from Edgartown Pizza (approx.. cost \$324+tax)
  - Popcorn Machine to be provided by Anne Fligor
  - o No Live animals to be given as prizes, this year or any year going forward
  - o Decorating starts at 2:00 Friday 10/25, Heidi McDonough volunteered to be there
- School Garden (Melinda Rabbit DeFeo)
  - Green house still requires electricity(3 bids @ \$10K), NStar unable to help divert some cost, must be run through school main grid. PTA has agreed to \$7,500 towards project, Melinda will fundraise as necessary to make up rest of budget (go Fund me perhaps)
  - Garden Club has 15 members, could use more parent help
  - Program in jeopardy due to loss of \$8,000 grant money that subsidized Melinda's salary
  - Garden program ranked one of the best on the East Coast, and contributions from program keep Gina and the lunch program a top rated by the USDA (local lamb, 600lbs of tomatoes from our own garden etc); facilitates field trips and creates food system awareness
  - o Perhaps set up a Garden/Parent liaison and/or committee

- Library (Nancy Cole)
  - Scholastic Book Fair: October 21 25. Need volunteers for Set up, break down, and scribing for K-1. All volunteers must be CORI checked (needs to be done annually)
  - Set up 10/18 @2:40, Nancy will be at Curriculum Night with sign up sheet for Set Up, Break down and scribing for younger grades
  - Later this year entire school (K-8) will be reading Wishtree by Katherine Applegate
- Boosterthon Glow Run (Jan 1- pep rally, Jan 24-run)
  - o Wild West theme
  - All sponsorship payments done on line (when can donations be initiated?)
  - Kids will need to obtain sponsors all done on line
  - Need at least 8 parent volunteers to coordinate with company (info meeting following pep rally 1/14 after school)
  - o Anne Fligor to coordinate with Boosterthon people about scheduling run times for school on 1/24
  - Need to sell sponsorships for Tshirts to off set cost (\$250/company) already have several in hand
  - o Utilize Room parents to find out Tshirt sizes, distribute prizes etc
- Aguarium Questions
  - Some families curious as to why fish tank seems empty despite investment of funds to maintain and improve it. There has been problems finding fish that thrive in the environment and further work needs to be done
  - Anne to follow up with Emily Reddington regarding fish
