Melinda has taken on another position as a private gardener but will not affect her role at the school. She is looking forward to her new position in which the private farm is willing to contribute fresh foods from the garden and resources to the school garden program. Soup/Cookie Fundraiser- Evening raised \$223; The plan for next year is to extend the sales and get it into the school calendar early as to not compete with other fundraisers. Suggested to schedule the kick-off for around Valentine's Day Weekend again and market as a "Warm Your Heart Event" – come for warm soup and cookies with Valentine theme. Could even have music/DJ for kids to dance or games to play. Need to have a more controlled environment for the kids so there are no injuries.
