Update regarding Stop and Shop A+ program (makes over \$5K for school annually, we're one of the highest grossing schools but could make more, does not effect gas points, sign up as many people as possible on line and on the app, possible table at Halloween Party to assist, send email with link, and add to Facebook to raise awareness)
- Nicole Barlett (School Nurse)- Health and Wellness Committee
 - Discussed Health Fair (9/11), requested grant for local honey for upcoming cold season, requested parent input about what they would like Health and Wellness com to address: suggested Doodle Poll to obtain answers (vaping, immunizations, sleep, tech/cyber security)
 Will provide date and times of upcoming H&W com meetings so PTA representative can attend
- School Garden (Melinda Rabbit DeFeo)
 - Green house still requires electricity(3 bids @ \$10K), waiting on Mike Dolby to speak with NStar to avoid extra cost of routing electric through school (does anyone know someone @NStar to facilitate) PTA has agreed to \$3,500 towards project, Melinda will fundraise as necessary to make up rest of budget

- Garden Account balance \$2173.99, expense report of \$776.05. PTA will provide funds for fall soil (\$750), Spring plant sale made over \$3000.
- Garden is curriculum based fully integrated on K level, would like more help esp. 1st grade parents
- o Perhaps set up a Garden/Parent liaison and/or committee
- Library (Nancy Cole)
 - Scholastic Book Fair: October 21 28. Need volunteers for Set up, break down, and scribing for K-1. All volunteers must be CORI checked (needs to be done annually) Will confirm time and day of set up and break down. (PTA splits proceeds of sale)

 - Later this year entire school (K-8) will be reading Wishtree by Katherine Applegate
