

Tuesday February 8th 7:00 pm via Zoom



Understanding Evaluations & Their Role in the IEP Process


Tuesday March 15th 7:00 pm

Effective Teams



What does this look like in the Team Meeting?

 Develop goals by starting with a conversation about data.

Ask:

- What will look different by next year at this time?
- What is one thing that will show the change we want to see?
- What do we regularly get from the student that we could collect and review to see progress in this area?
- Write goals using language that everyone understands. Ask the student or parent:
 - How would you describe the change we want to see?
 - What will make you feel like success is happening? How can we write that here in one sentence?
