III. Finance Report - Mark Friedman

A. Expense Report - the General Fund budget looks good and the current challenge is filling vacancies - there is one overage in general maintenance due to the elevator repairs and complications. The elevator is now working and passed inspection.

A. General Update - The first full MCAS test was given last spring. Edgartown School was above statewide trends in all areas. The scores will inform our teaching.

V. Principal's Report

A. Eighth Grade Trip - Kara Gelinas Advisor

There are 3 advisors in total due to the class size: Kara Gelinas 5 / 6 Science teacher, Celia Mercier grade 7 / 8 Math teacher and Brian Perry grade 5 / 6 Social Studies Teacher.

Kara Gelinas presented a proposal to change the destination from Washington DC to NYC and Philadelphia. The out of state trip requires permission from the School Committee and the vote on that was postponed to the November meeting.

B. Update on Band Program - Ian Lisi, Band Teacher

Ian Lisi presented information about the band programming

C. Enrollment - 402 students with a few pending.

D. Special Events - Children's Day was celebrated on October 12 and went very well. Parent - Teacher conferences are coming up. The first Fun-Run is on October 31.

E. Elevator Update - The elevator is working and passed inspection.

Additional Updates: The Edgartown School met the most strict lead and copper water testing requirements. There is a delay on the Boys and Girls Club building project. The school is forming a committee to replace the playground equipment.

1. New Hires - a 1:1 ESP will be needed for a student who is moving to the district from Tisbury. Circuit Breaker Funds can be used to fund this new ESP position.
