414 students and no pending enrollments 10 new students have joined the school since February 1. There are 60 students in 8th grade, the largest in recent history.

Next year, if the numbers do not change, there will be: 3 Kindergarten classrooms, 3 First Grade Classrooms, 2 Second Grade Classrooms, 3 Third, Fourth and Fifth

Grade Classrooms, two 6th Grade classrooms, 3 7th Grade classrooms and 2 8th Grade classrooms.

There was a recent meeting with Kindergarten teachers, member of the school committee, a union representative, and Dr. Einbinder regarding additional support for the current Kindergarten classrooms. An additional substitute teacher who works 4 days a week was hired to support the classrooms.
